## From the Pastor's desk...

"Best Sunday Morning Question"

One of our professors in seminary (the school that trains pastors) was in a Church job where he didn't have to be at Church every Sunday. He told us about his Sunday mornings - how he would wake up and think, "Should I go to Church today?" He was as human as the rest of us, and lots of questions would crowd his mind: Wouldn't it be nice to sleep in? What if the music wasn't his style? Maybe he could stay home and cook brunch. Or, would there be good food at coffee hour?

But he still found his way to Church each Sunday.

How? He told us his secret.

When those other questions poured in, he would ask himself this:

"Is God good?"

And the answer, to him, was always YES. So, because God is good, he found himself wanting (more than anything, even more than sleep or brunch) to worship God. To say thank you. To hear the Word about this God. To join with other people in praise. To pray with other people for a world in need. To turn worship into service, finding more opportunities to love his neighbor.

Now, I know that we have questions about God's goodness. The world is messed up. People of faith are messed up too. Why hasn't God fixed it all? I honor those questions and the pain in them. And, I also know that even when things aren't good, God still is. Sometimes mysteriously so, but usually good in ways that are evident. I don't have to look far to find something to say thank you for. I don't have to look far to see a neighbor who God wants me to love. And for these, we need worship to inspire and sustain us.
