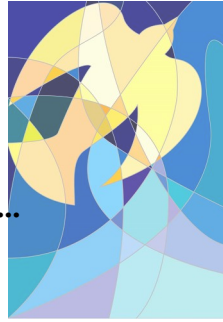


Spirit, Lead Us: Grace's Ministry Retreat Series

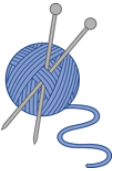
